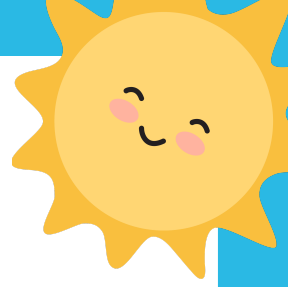

My favourite memory.....

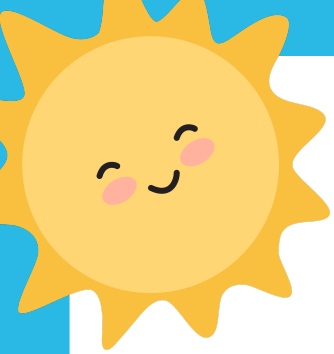
