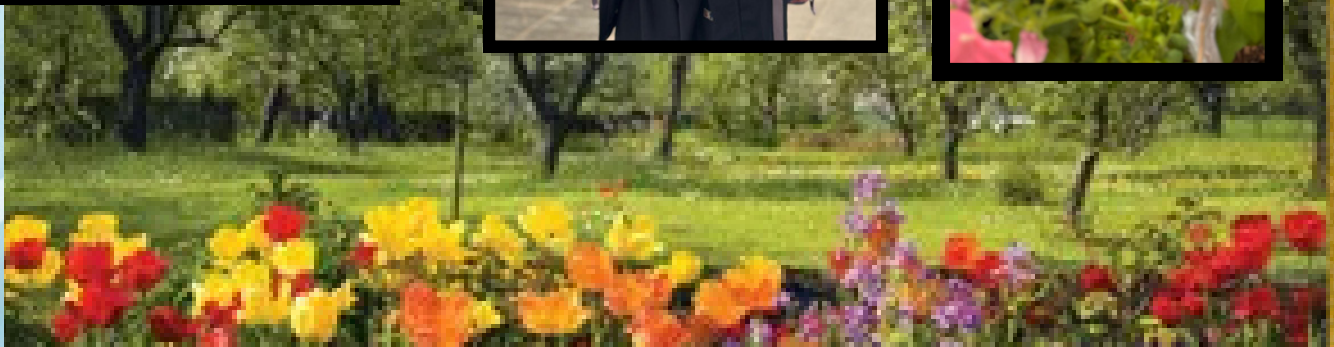

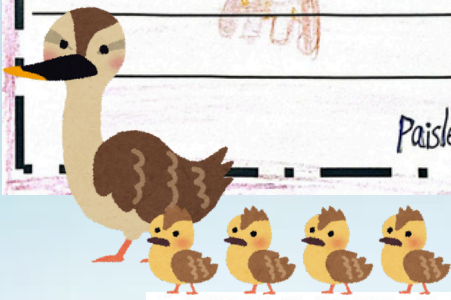

Longer Days: As spring progresses, the days get longer and the nights get shorter. This means more time to play outside after school.



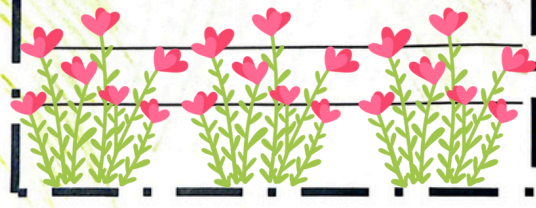

Tips for a Foggy Spring in Hong Kong



In spring, the weather in Hong Kong is warm and foggy. Fog forms when the difference between air temperature and dew point is less than 2.5 °C. Fog begins to form when water vapour condenses into tiny water droplets that are suspended in the air.

When it is foggy, the relative humidity is near 100%. The scene is blurred and not clearly seen. Wet ceilings, slippery floors and water droplets on walls give Hong Kong people plenty to sweat about.

To overcome these conditions, you may use a dehumidifier. You may also keep windows closed or open a little and turn on fans at low speed.

*In spring many birds migrate back north after winter, returning to build nests and lay eggs.

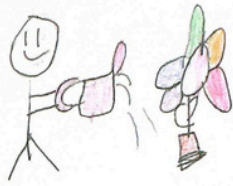
